

WHAT ARE THE JOB DUTIES OF A CNA?

The CNA provides personal care to residents or patients, such as bathing, dressing, changing linens, transporting, and other essential activities. They work under the supervision of a LPN or RN. A Certified Nursing Assistant may do many or all of the following duties:

- Obtain vital signs
- Performs non-invasive monitoring as directed by the RN or LPN
- Observes for and reports to the RN or LPN unexpected situations
- Expresses needs, and changes in the resident's condition and behaviors
- Monitors and documents the resident's intake and output
- Documents care and observations thoroughly and accurately
- Feeds and assists residents with nutritional intake and follows dietary restrictions
- Assists residents with hygiene and grooming needs
- Transfers and assists residents with ambulation and mobility needs
- Assists residents with active and passive range of motion exercises
- Performs routine care of urinary drainage devices
- Applies anti-embolism stockings
- Reapplies cannula and oxygen masks for residents already receiving oxygen therapy
- Collects specimens as directed by the RN/LPN
- Utilizes assistive devices, wheelchairs, and other equipment safely
- Assists residents to activities and supports emotional health

CNA TRAINING PROGRAM

Students gain an understanding of the responsibilities involved in working with residents/patients of all ages in both wellness and illness. Issues of mental health, resident/patient rights, and resident/patient and family interactions are also covered. Class instruction includes the following:

- Basic nursing assistant procedures and skills
- Restorative services
- General household activities
- Patient care
- Safety and emergency care

The Columbine Health Systems class includes 92 hours of training. Classroom instruction and lab are held weekdays for 10 days. Two and one-half days of hands-on clinical experience with residents is provided at 1 of the 4 skilled nursing facilities of Columbine Health Systems.
